Sport is a high priority for Blaby Stokes C of E Primary School, we believe it has a huge impact on pupils' well-being and fitness as well as academic achievement. Engagement in a variety of sports and fitness opportunities is key for all pupils.

We believe that we have used the sports funding effectively to support provision and set up a sustainable future for children at Blaby Stokes. We have a specific governor with responsibility for PE who ensures that funding is well managed and spent effectively.

Use of PE and Sport Funding

- ❖ Paying for professional development for sports leader and other staff
- ❖ Specific dance training from an external provider
- ❖ Supporting staff in developing skills in order to sustain teaching for indoor PE
- ❖ Paying for lunchtime and afterschool clubs provision
- ❖ Supporting 2 Sport apprenticeships – one employed as a second year apprentice on a full time basis
- ❖ Supplementing funding for children to attend sports activities
- ❖ Fitness Fun – every morning – 2 members of staff each day
- ❖ Organization of sports ambassadors
- ❖ Running sport competitions within the County and local schools
- ❖ Paying for medals, trophies certificates and stickers
- ❖ Transport for pupils to area sports
- ❖ New equipment for basketball including outdoor hoops
- ❖ Sports kit for teams

Impact of PE and Sport Funding

This year we have managed to double our participation in sport at school. So far this year we have entered over 150 pupils into competitions. This is over 50% of the school from Year 1 – 6. They have participated in Football, Tag Rugby, Basketball, Benchball and Multi-Sports entering 24 teams across all competitions.

Having two apprentices has helped us grow our already popular lunch and after school

sports, with over 150 children being able to join in for free after school and 100 during lunch times. Our 2nd year apprentice has also started to work with teachers to improve their knowledge of sports they are not as confident in.

Dance CPD for staff enabled staff to provide focused lessons, evidence of which has been observed in lessons and presented to parent groups. Dance is forming part of our school 50/60 year celebrations in the Summer term.

PE is run by a sports specialist who gained their level 5 PE coordinators last year which has helped them develop the PE within the school. With help from the apprentices we have been able to devise a PE curriculum that is more focused on the individual. We now have a scale that the children work to so we can see their strengths and weaknesses.

- **How we will make sure these improvements are sustainable**

Next year when the second year apprentice has completed his course, he will be employed by the school to run Key Stage 1 PE. He will take all of his knowledge from his 2 years as an apprentice and put it into practice. This will also help the school run more teams and a bigger variety of after school activities.

Teachers will continue to work alongside the PE specialist and apprentices to further develop their skills so that we provide the best provision for our pupils health and well-being.

We are hoping for another two first year apprentices to work alongside our PE specialists. This will mean we can offer the same amount of support to the pupils. This will mean we can carry on with focusing more on the individuals.

We will look to offer more opportunities to children with our connections with sports clubs outside of school.
